General Information

- **Event Dates:** The SLIET Innovation Summit 2024 will be held on 20th and 21st September.
- **Venue:** Sant Longowal Institute of Engineering and Technology (SLIET).

Participation

- **Participation Fee:** The participation fee for each participant is ₹250.
- **Accommodation/Staying Charges:** Nominal accommodation charges are to be paid upon arrival at the registration desk.
- **Faculty:** Accompanying faculty must be informed by the registering college to the organizing team through the website istesliet.com/summit.

Code of Conduct

- **Discipline:** Any act of indiscipline will lead to immediate disqualification from the event.
- **Attendance:** Participants must attend all seminars and workshops. Failure to do so may result in disqualification or demerit points.

Registration

- **Registration Process:** Participants must register through the official registration portal.

Event Description:

- **Quiz:** The Quiz Competition at SLJET Innovation Summit challenges participants with 20 questions over 25 minutes, focusing on AI trends and Day 1 workshop topics. Teams of 1-2 members compete for top honors, with the organizing committee retaining the right to modify rules before the quiz starts.
- **Debate:** The Debate Competition at SLJET Innovation Summit involves teams of 2-4 members debating AI topics. The event features elimination rounds until one winner remains. Topics are assigned three days prior, and a wildcard entry system is in place. Debates last up to 8 minutes per team.
- **AI Tales:** AI Tales at SLJET Innovation Summit is a storytelling competition focusing on AI themes. Participants craft engaging narratives about AI's impact, using creative and original content. Stories are presented to a live audience and judged on storytelling skills, relevance, creativity, and emotional impact. The best storyteller wins recognition and prizes.
- **AI Pitchdeck:** The AI Startup Pitch Competition at SLJET Innovation Summit allows AI startups to pitch their innovative ideas to potential investors. Participants present their solutions, receive feedback, and may secure real-time funding. The event fosters entrepreneurship and innovation, offering a platform to turn AI concepts into reality. No cash prize is awarded.
- **MysteryMaze:** Mystry Maze at SLJET Innovation Summit is an AI-driven treasure hunt. Teams of 3-6 solve riddles using AI tools, navigating through checkpoints to uncover the final prize. The 2-hour event challenges problem-solving and teamwork, with one winning team rewarded with cash prizes or goodies.

- **InfinityForge:** Compete in classic squad mode across dynamic maps, showcasing your gaming skills and strategic prowess. This exciting tournament invites teams of up to four players to battle it out for prestigious titles and prizes. Experience intense gameplay, teamwork, and the thrill of being the last squad standing. Participants must adhere to all rules and guidelines for a fair and enjoyable competition. Join us and prove your mettle in the ultimate BGMI showdown!

Participants present their solutions in a structured 10-slide format, emphasizing creativity, thoroughness, and originality. Teams must demonstrate their real-life models or prototypes alongside their presentations, showcasing practical applications and innovative solutions. Join us to push technological boundaries and showcase AI-driven engineering prowess.
